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Main conclusions of the Web Research

- Most of the courses are free of charge which is common in Finland.
- There are actually not many courses that are specified for 50 + people only.
- Most of the courses are general and open to anyone, but the activity time between 9-15 o'clock indicates seniority target group.

Main learning opportunities for people + 50

- The **University of the Third Age**, which is a part of **the Open University**. It was founded in 1985. University of the Third Age is a meeting point for scientific knowledge and life experience.
- The Finnish Association of Adult Education Centers, which acts as an umbrella organization for **the adult education centers** in Finland. KoL, founded in 1919, is a non-governmental organization (NGO) the main task of which is to improve and promote adult education and learning in Finland.
- The **Summer Universities in Finland**. There are 20 summer universities in Finland, and they organize courses both in cities and smaller towns across the country throughout the year.
